


CHEVY / GM #4449 OE Puck Mounting Bracket Kit for SuperGlide #2700 & #2900



SYSTEM TOW CAPACITY

Please note, in order to determine the total tow capacity of a system, you must consider the weight ratings of each component in that system. This includes, but may not be limited to, the capacity/rating of the tow vehicle, the fifth wheel hitch, and the hitch's mounting system. Actual tow capacity of the system will be equal to the lowest rated component.

 - Custom Mounting Bracket Kit (Bracket & Hardware) #4449

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


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



ATTACHING KIT TO HITCH

Be aware when attaching brackets, each one is different and unique to its place on the hitch base. Note the direction of the lock handles and that passenger side bracket post holes are larger.




- 1. Place the brackets on the #2700 or #2900 SuperGlide base with Backer Plates and attach each using (2) 1/2-13 X 4 Hex bolts, (2) 1/2"-13 serrated flange nuts, and (2) Conical serrated wash ers (place serrated teeth facing the bracket). Place all brackets starting at the 3rd hole from the rear (tailgate) end on the SuperGlide base.
- 2. Hand tighten all hex bolts at this point. Keep them a little loose for an easier Install.




BUILD THE POST ASSEMBLY

Build the (4) post assemblies used for clamping hitch to the bed of the truck.




- 1. Place the Base Washer down on the Post.
- 2. Thread Castle Nut onto the Post.
- 3. Align the Lock Handle 90 degrees to the direction of the Spring Pin and place on top of the Post, the handle cut-out fits down over the square top on Post.
- 4. Add the Washer and Button Head Screw and tighten with a 3/16 hex key.


INSTALLING THE HITCH



- 1. Place the (4) Brass Puck Washer in the *OE* pucks on truck bed (FIG.1). They should easily fit into the puck. In some instances, it may be necessary to lightly file the Brass Puck Washers to get them to fit as puck tolerances may vary. For the Passenger side, make sure to use Spacer Plates between Brass Puck Washer and bracket
- 2. Place the hitch over the Brass Puck Washers and Spacer Plates. They should all be visible through the post holes on brackets. Line up the driver side front puck first and take one Mounting Post assembly and drop it into the puck as shown (FIG.2). Press down and turn 90 degrees inward to the Lock Tab. It should be tight enough to take some force by hand to lock it in place. If it is loose, tighten the Castle Nut a few turns and re-insert Mounting Post assembly and lock it into the puck.
- 3. Next, move the rear of the hitch until it falls in alignment with driver side rear puck if it isn't already. You should be able to insert the Mounting Post assembly and lock it in the puck.




INSTALLING THE HITCH



- 4. Repeat step 2 on the passenger side Mounting Post assemblies.
- 5. Feed each Cotter Pin through the Castle Nut and pre-drilled hole on the Posts (FIG.3).

 Bend ends of cotter pin to prevent it from sliding out. This will prevent the Mounting Post assemblies from loosening.
- 6. At this point with the all of the Mounting Post assemblies in the pucks, tighten all 1/2"-13 X 4" Bracket Hex Bolts to 75 foot pounds.
- 7. With Lock Handles aligned with the holes in the Lock Tabs (FIG.5), place Bail Pins through each hole. Snap the loop over the end of Bail Pin to lock.
